Program notes:

Don Freund's *Life of the Party* (Concerto for Bassoon and 16 Friends) could be described as an instrumental mini-opera with two identifiable layers of musical activity. One layer is the "Party Music," a series of "songs" in varied vernacular styles which recede into the background to allow the more intimate party "Chats" to be heard. The scenario is this: the bassoon and its date, the contrabassoon, show up at a party, and before long engage in a "Small-Talk Chat" with the other woodwinds — a breezy triple-triple meter against the heavy duple of the "Hard Rock Party Music." When a new "Gospel Party Music" begins, the bassoon and contra begin an earnest, spirited discussion of religion with the electric piano, later joined by the marimba. This odd mixture of gospel blues, Messiaen-ic chords, and simulated Gregorian chant yields to the next party music, a robotic "Techno" passacaglia, over which the bassoon and brass trio engage in a heated debate about politics. This stark tension is replaced by the thick, rich harmonies of the "Posh Party Music," over which the bassoon and piano (later joined by the flute and clarinet) discuss sports in 16th-note flurries of sinewy athleticism. The string quartet interrupts, advancing some abstract theories of art; the bassoon sympathizes, while "Cool Jazz Party Music" is heard in the background. A sultry "Blues Party Music" follows, with sexy electric guitar riffs that elicit some flagrant flirtation from the bassoon. The contrabassoon is outraged, and retaliates by becoming closely intertwined with the electric bass. A lovers' spat erupts, a duo-cadenza for bassoon and contra, full of choice multiphonics and other extended effects. During the ensuing "Deep Funk Party Music" the bassoon goes off by itself as has a cry. The contra re-enters, and reconciliation is found in a country-flavored Ballad. All is well; the party ends with a rollicking celebration!

Life of the Party was inspired by the incomparably vivacious personality and astounding virtuosity of Kim Walker.



Recommended stage configuration:



During the "Chats", concertante players are asked to stand, with the exception of the string quartet.

All Winds: Staccato marks between the note-head and a slur indicate a light tonguing; staccato marks placed outside the slur indicate a quick release with no re-articulation.

Bassoon and Contrabassoon: Three complementary bits of information are given for most multiphonics: a whimsical description, an even more whimsical chord or cluster notation, and a fingering used by Kim Walker in the first performance. Bassoonists are encouraged to take all of these into account, and then use whatever works best for their instrument.

Percussion: The following instruments are employed:

Vibraphone, Marimba, Bass Drum, Small Tamtam,
5 Temple Blocks, Bongos, Guiro, Cowbell, Finger Cymbals

Synthesizer (Piano): Two synthesizer voices are called for: "Rhodes piano" — an electric piano sound with a lot of high partial "ping"; and "Hammond organ" which should be disruptively loud and rich in measure 236. "Damper pedal" is not required, but a volume pedal could be used, and velocity sensitivity is necessary.


Electric Guitar: The Electric Guitar part has been edited by Derek Johnson: all his fingerings and suggestions appear in the full score as well. Three levels of distortion are indicated:

"light distortion" is akin to blues or southern rock, slight buzz, but lots of note
(could be achieved without distortion setting on amp or pedal by boosting tone
or playing with bridge pickup, or both);

"medium distortion" is akin to rock or fusion, gritty but still some note;

"heavy distortion" is akin to hard rock or metal.
